

Applying for membership at Mallard Trap Club

1. Download and complete application found at the bottom of this page. All fields must be completed in full and legible to be accepted.
2. Bring completed application to New Member Orientation which is held on last Sunday of each month during normal operating hours. Current operating hours are listed on range schedule listed on our website.

Please email the membership committee 1 week prior to ensure someone will be present to meet with you.

3. Please be sure to bring the following when submitting your application:
 - a. Valid Driver's license
 - b. State firearms ID card
 - c. Initiation fee and prorated dues per payment schedule on this sheet below
 - d. Legal shotgun and box of ammo

You will be required to shoot 10-15 rounds of trap to demonstrate safe gun handling and firearms proficiency to the committee.

If any of the identifying items are not brought with you as listed above, you will be asked to resubmit your application at the next scheduled meeting.

4. The membership committee will answer any questions you may have and go through the operations/regulations of the club as well as run you through the procedure of running the club while performing range duties.
5. You will be asked to attend the next general meeting at which time your application for membership will be brought up and voted on.
6. Upon successful initiation to the club, you will be expected to sign up for (4) range duties before leaving for the evening.

You are at this point a probationary member for 12 months. Upon completion of 12 months probation and you have been in good standings, at the next scheduled meeting you will obtain full membership status upon receiving a positive vote of two-thirds of the members present.
